IZOTE was founded as a registered 501c3 non-profit organization in 2010 in order to support community development projects for financially impoverished communities in rural El Salvador and Central America.

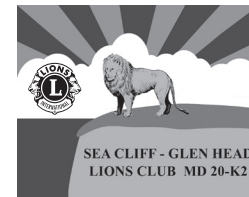
IZOTE seeks to strengthen communities by improving literacy, health care and by promoting the sustainable use and conservation of natural resources.
